Whole School Attendance and Punctuality

The whole school attendance target is **96.5%**. Each week we will advise you of the percentage we achieved. Last week, we achieved **96.93%** which exceeds our target figure. Punctuality was slightly improved with 44 late marks across the school which is better but still higher than we would like. Please make every effort to get your child to school on time. From September until last Friday, the whole school attendance is 97.04% which exceeds our target, and there have been 433 late marks.
