The weeks have flown past as we enter the last few days of this half-term. The children have been working towards an **art exhibition** for the last few weeks and one piece from each child will be exhibited in the gym on **Friday** after school. Last summer we had a similar event and we hope this will be as successful and well-attended by parents.

This week parents will be invited to sign-up for **teacher/parent conferences**. We successfully trialled an online method of booking appointments last autumn and will be using the same site again this term. We are giving a lot of notice prior to the conferences and if you find after booking that you need to change your time please do this so that slots can be re-allocated to other parents. The online booking system will go live at **12pm tomorrow**.
