Most of our late marks are less than 10 minutes, so it may be worth considering leaving home just that 10 minutes earlier if you can.

Could we please also ask that once you have collected your child, you leave the building as promptly as possible. ## **School Admissions**

Primary school entry from September 2017 (Reception class) If your child was born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013 you will need to apply for a primary school place from September 2016, Your child will be due to start in September 2017. The closing date for applications is 15 January 2017.

#### **Finance Matters**

All payments to school must be made via ParentPay.

Please note that breakfast and tea time clubs must be kept in credit at all times. We have a waiting list for both these clubs so failure to keep your account in credit may lead to your child being removed from the club and their space offered to another child.

Our late collection policy for Tea Time Club is also being enforced. 5 minutes late collection incurs a £5 fine. Every five minutes or part thereof after will incur an additional £5. This fine will be added to your ParentPay account.

Similarly, dinner money accounts should be kept up to date. Failure to do so could mean that you are asked to provide a packed lunch until your child's account is back in credit.

Don't forget for Key Stage 2, payment is due for our trip to the Panto and Year 6 parents, don't forget that payments can be made at any time for your child's Residential trip later next year.
