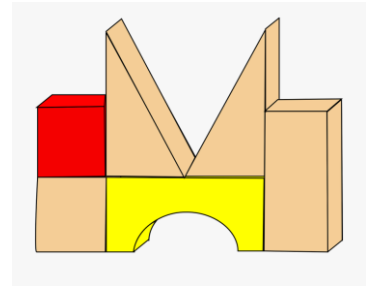
Bats at the ready! Come and join us practise our cricket skills and work together to play matches.

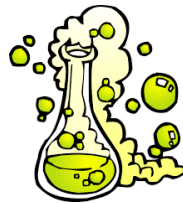
If you're interested in designing and building interesting structures, construction club is for you.

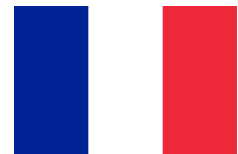
Was 'flossing' your thing? Are you always keeping up with the latest dance crazes? Why not join our dance club—show off your moves and work together with friends to create routines to show us all!

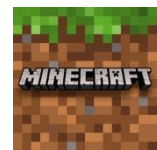
Do you like making games, animations and websites? Come along to practise your coding skills.

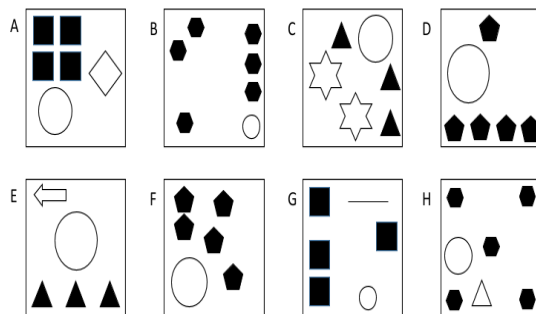
Ukulele Club
