Dear Parents and carers,

As we come to the end of our first week of this new academic year, I have to congratulate the children on their resilience and ability to adapt to the new systems and structures in place. Despite these changes, they have settled in quickly and have already been impressing me and their teachers with their fantastic work and behaviour.

I would also like to thank you for your patience and understanding as we adapt to new routines. May I take this opportunity to remind you that you must keep a 2m distance at the school gates and wear a face covering when dropping off and collecting your children. Additionally, for the safety of the children, I must also remind you not to drive to the school entrances at Chestnut North and Chestnut South. Myself and all of the staff are grateful for your support and cooperation during these unusual times.

As part of our measures to keep everyone safe, children no longer hang their bags and coats on pegs. This means that children must bring their bag into their classroom and store it beneath their chair. Backpacks and other large bags do not fit under chairs and for this reason, I ask that your child comes to school with only one, small bag. A school book bag, for example, is the ideal size. They can hold a book and a packed lunch and they fit safely beneath a chair.

Communication between staff and parents is incredibly important and we recognise that this is more difficult with drop offs and collections. I am pleased to let you know that Mrs Howarth will be our dedicated Parent Liaison Officer.

I will end with a verse from 1 Thessalonians 5:11 which reflects this week's value of 'caring and the importance of supporting each other: 'Therefore, encourage one another and build each other up.'

This week, Year 4 children have completed their first project. Using TinkerCAD, they layered shapes, adjusted sizing and navigated their workspace to design a chess piece.




Parent Liaison Officer
